In striving to serve our referring agencies and clients better, we ask that the following information be available when the client calls us to sign up for a program:

Client information, such as:

- Full name
- Mailing address
- Social Security or Driver's License number
- Phone number
- Date of birth

Court information, including:

- Name of the court ordering the class
- Name of the class to be completed
- Court case/ticket number
- Conviction date
- Charge
- Completion due date
- If an accident was involved
- SIS date (is the class being completed in lieu of points or is it a Suspended Imposition of Sentence – SIS?)
